Types of presentations

The conference invites submissions for two types of presentations:

- Paper presentation
- Symposium (a panel/group discussing a topic)

Abstracts

Abstracts of 200-300 words each must be addressed to: emasa2009@easyabstract.com (*indicate in the subject line that it is your “abstract”*) on or before **30 May 2009**. Notification of acceptance will be sent to presenters by 22 June 2009. Your submission must be made in a word document.

- **NB It should be noted that papers for this conference have to focus on Education Administration, Management and Leadership.**

FULL PAPERS

The complete paper in word document format must reach: emasa2009@easyabstract.com (*indicate in the subject line that it is your “full paper”*) on or before **15 July 2009**. Papers must be at most 5000 words in length.

- **Please note that presenters whose papers have not been submitted by 15 July will be removed from the programme.**

TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS

The abstracts and papers must be typed on A4 pages, 2cm margins, in 1½ line spacing, 12 pt type Arial font.
